NOTICE OF OBJECTION

(Pursuant to The Unclaimed Personal Property and Vested Property Act)

This notice is for use by holders who wish to make a formal objection to the requirement to pay, transfer or deliver unclaimed personal property or vested property pursuant to the Unclaimed Personal Property and Vested Property Act. This notice is also for the use of claimants to make a formal objection regarding a claim that has been disallowed either in full or in part.

Every property to which an objection is taken will require a separate Notice of Objection. Where the facts and reasons set out in one Notice duplicate the facts and reasons of another, this may be indicated, and the provision of one statement of facts and reasons will suffice.

For each Notice of Objection one completed copy (signed by the claimant or holder who objects or, in the case of a business, by an authorized officer of the business) must be sent by registered or certified mail or by courier to TAX SERVICES, TAX AND REVENUE ADMINISTRATION, 9811 109 ST, EDMONTON AB T5K 2L5, within 120 days for a holder from the end of the reporting year or for all other cases the receipt of a determination.

It is recommended that initially, an attempt be made to resolve any disagreements with Tax and Revenue Administration prior to filing a formal Notice of Objection. You may write Tax and Revenue Administration at the above address or phone 780-427-3044. If calling long distance within Alberta, call 310-0000 then enter 780-427-3044. Fax 780-427-3770. Should it not be possible to resolve the disagreement by this means, please ensure that the required Notice of Objection is properly filed within the 120 day period mentioned above.
