TITLE: Automobile Insurance Endorsement Revisions
SEF # 16 Suspension of Coverage Endorsement
SEF # 17 Reinstatement of Coverage Endorsement

TO: All Alberta licensed automobile insurance companies

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Bulletin is to advise you that the SEF # 16 Suspension of Coverage Endorsement (“SEF 16”) and the SEF # 17 Reinstatement of Coverage Endorsement (“SEF 17”) have been revised effective immediately. The [revised documents are available on our website](#). These two endorsements are approved for use only in Alberta. They provide for the suspension and reinstatement of Section A – “Third Party Liability” coverage; Section B – “Accident Benefits” coverage; and Section C “All Perils” but only for loss or damage caused by “Collision or Upset”, or Section C “Collision or Upset” subsections.

Effective immediately, Alberta licensed automobile insurers may use these newly revised SEF 16 and the SEF 17 on new policies.

Effective June 1, 2016 the Superintendent of Insurance will revoke the former SEF 16, and the SEF 17. Insurers may not use these former endorsements on new or renewing Alberta automobile insurance policies issued from June 1, 2016.

For those policies in force prior to June 1, 2016, that have the former SEF 16, and/or the former SEF 17 attached, those former endorsements continue to apply to those policies until expiry date.
